

Dear CLC Friends,

2023 has been an amazing and blessed year for CLC International. We are thankful to the Lord for His continuing faithfulness. Many of our countries are distributing more Christian literature in our shops and on-line than pre-Covid. Notably, new CLC shops have opened in Colombia, Kenya and Myanmar.

Yet, that is only part of the post-Covid story as we are also busy with outreaches. In this issue you can read of just two important examples of CLC again attending book fairs in Panama and the Philippines in our desire to use Christian books to help people come to faith and mature in Jesus Christ.

We are also excited about several building projects for new CLC shops. In November, CLC Ecuador opened their new shop and wholesale centre in the port city of Guayaquil. CLC Sierra Leone have just opened a newly built shop in the inland city of Bo (see pages 6 & 7). CLC Panama was recently able to purchase a foreclosed property at an excellent price in the city of David, near Costa Rica. They will soon begin construction on a new bookshop. CLC-ELS India is constructing a new shop with a large conference room in the coastal city of Chennai.

Finally, CLC is initiating a wonderful project to print 25,000 children's Bibles for some needy countries such as Bulgaria, India, Mozambique, Pakistan, Portugal, and Francophone West Africa.

All of these projects require faith in the Lord to supply the necessary funds to see the ministry continue to expand. See page 23 to see how you can support one of these important projects.

Every year since 2003, CLC Panama has had the privilege of participating in the Panamanian International Book Fair. This is the largest book fair in the country and this year (2023) there were over 100,000 people in attendance.

The theme of the conference was *Identity* and *Origin*, and the seven Panamanian native tribes were highlighted. International authors and visitors are drawn to the fair each year, giving us the opportunity to reach people who would not normally shop in one of our bookstores.

A team of 25 individuals worked day and night to make sure our stand was ready to go before the fair started. Our space was visible and attracted attention thanks to the publishers who sponsored special banners for our stand. We had a large selection of materials available for



customers. We praise God that all the shipments arrived on time for one of our largest events of the year.

The Panamanian Book Chamber invited Omayra Font, pastor and author, as one of the guests and speakers at this year's fair. We are a distributor of Omayra's books. Attendees were excited to see her, get their books signed, and to speak with her briefly. A large number of Christians in Panama read her books so this was a very special and memorable experience for our customers.

Andra Lino, a member of the Emberá tribe and a leader of her region, visited our stand, purchased a book for her children, and shared with us that she was really encouraged by the knowledge we imparted during the book fair. She was especially excited about our work through our social foundation. We praise God for the many opportunities and divine appointments we were able to have at the 2023 Panamanian International Book Fair, Please pray for the 2024 Fair. May we be able to reach even more people and provide the materials our Christian brothers and sisters need.

UPDATE: Sierra Leone

It has been more than three years since I started partnering with the CLC Africa Director (Liz Patten), working together with the national CLC team in Sierra Leone.

During this period, many shipments of new & second hand books and Bibles have arrived in the port of Freetown. Most of these have come from various American publishers (including CLC USA who has kindly consolidated all the orders for us), a church in Canada and KCLCT in the UK. All of this has significantly increased our ministry potential, with the majority of these books and Bibles now in the hands of spiritually hungry Christians as well as unbelievers looking for answers to their spiritual emptiness.

We are also privileged to partner and cooperate with Crossway Publishers in the USA. They have provided us with several special book sets that we have been able to distribute to pastors in different provinces, especially thinking of those who are far away from one of our three Christian bookshops in the country. For many years, Crossway's mission has been to publish gospel-centred content that honours our Saviour and serves His church







Alongside the positive notes, we have also had various challenges. Instances of these include acts of vandalism and theft at our bookshops, to the extent that we have needed to employ a night security guard. There have also been many occasions of unrest since the last elections, which have caused the capital city to shut down for days. Power outages are common. Life is tough in Sierra Leone and we regularly praise God for the faithfulness of our national staff and their desire to see Bibles and other Christian resources made available in their country.

In addition to the bookshops, we are able to run an outreach activity in Bo Town and the surrounding area, using a recently purchased Kéké, or motorised tricycle. This was made possible due to many generous donations from the UK, Canada and the USA.

Another fund-raising project involves the construction of a new bookshop in Bo Town, based on our constant desire to see a long-term future for a CLC ministry there. The bookshop and outreach in Bo are managed by married couple, Matthew & Isata Ndoinjeh. Having our own bookshop will not only release us

from having to pay an ever-increasing amount in rent, but it will also provide CLC with more space. The new bookshop will not only be located in the centre of town, but in a church complex which is home to many church conventions and other activities.

I want to thank everyone who has given financially to support this ministry and to make it into "mission possible", as well as those who have given their time and/or have provided good second hand Christian books and Bibles. Those of you who pray are also much appreciated! The ministry doesn't just happen, so please do continue with your support in whatever form, so that the ministry will continue in Sierra Leone.

In September of 2023 CLC Philippines had the opportunity to participate in the 45th Manila International Book Fair (MIBF). This event took place in September and ran for four days.

This Book Fair is one of the longestrunning book fairs in Asia and one of the most anticipated in our country. The event originally drew people from the publishing and academic industry but it has now transformed into a family and reader-friendly event.

The Book Fair was held at a prestigious venue, the SMX Convention Center located in the sprawling Mall of Asia Complex. The exhibition area consists of four halls with a floor area of around 9130 square meters and a 1980 square meter main lobby.

This year's MIBF was well-attended, attracting more than 10,000 visitors. CLC had four booths, two of which were sponsored. Prior to the event we prayed that our imported products would arrive before the month of September. The Lord had other plans, though. Our imports arrived in October, a month after the event. But we are thankful to God that we could sell stock from previous shipments. We are thankful

that we also gained a significant amount of new customers, including the Adventist Palawan Mission that purchased reference books. Our customers are Bible schools, churches, mission organisations, Catholic-run universities, private institutions, as well as the public.

We had total sales of approximately USD15,000 with further orders processed after the event. We had products from CLC Publications, Bibles, reference materials, planners, calendars, and other gift items.

Planning for this event takes a year. We select our booth location and a series of meetings with the organizer follows. Promotion for the event is done by the organizer who partners with other media outlets in the Philippines.

We are asking the Lord for more sponsors for our booths for 2024. We would like to have four sponsored booths. Some publishers have already expressed a desire to sponsor two of the booths next year. Pray for our team as we prepare for the 2024 International Book Fair, as it takes a significant amount of planning and work.

The Weekend (27th - 28th) - Regional Director


