Impacting lives through books

A 70 Year Ministry in India

This year marks the 70th anniversary of the Evangelical Literature Service in the beautiful and diverse nation of India, which is home to 1.39 billion people.

The work is continuing to grow and includes 23 bookstores, publishing, mobile ministry, outlets, and web sales.

How the Work Began

The ministry of ELS was founded by Donald David in 1946. He dedicated his life to the Lord at the age of 12, not knowing the challenges that lay ahead. At 14 he had a traumatic football accident which left him disabled for several years. During his recovery,

Donald felt a calling to the book-selling ministry. Inspired by D.L. Moody's work with the Moody Colportage Association which aimed to make affordable evangelical books available to everyone, Donald felt prompted by the Lord to do the same in India.

As he recuperated, Donald was able to undergo literature training through CLC in London. In 1954 he partnered with CLC UK, and the ministry began to grow significantly. Today, ELS has 23 centers across nine states in India: Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra, Punjab, Delhi, Dimapur, Secunderabad and Pondicherry. What originally started in a small rented room in India has blossomed under the guidance and faithfulness of the Lord into what we see today.

The four-storey building will have parking on the ground floor, a 222 m² showroom, conference rooms, and a large number of rooms to accommodate guests on the top floor.

The need for Christian literature in India is truly significant and this new shop and building will be another major step in the journey of the ministry in India, where 74.3% of the population practice Hinduism.

The youngest of six, Justin was born into a pastoral family. His father, born Hindu, accepted Jesus as his Saviour after seeing the Lord move greatly in his family. Justin committed his life to the Lord at 14 years old, but because of the hardships he saw in the ministry, he decided to follow a different path. The Lord had a different plan. After completing his studies, Justin got a job in a software company where he worked for some time. One day, after interviewing for a new position in a well-known software company, a friend took him to ELS for another interview. Justin received offers from both places and, with great anticipation, showed his father, hoping his father would encourage him to join the software company. To Justin's surprise, his father insisted he join ELS. With great hesitation and confusion, without a clear call, Justin joined ELS in 1990. The Lord then gave him a burden to do ministry through the print page. Justin joined the accounting team and by the grace of God was able to learn and grasp all the principles of accounting. As the department moved from physical to digital accounting, Justin was able

to develop software for the accounts. It was then that he fully realised the calling of God and started serving the Lord wholeheartedly.

In 2004, God allowed him to become the Chief Accountant for the mission, and in the next year, Justin became a member of the leadership team. In 2014, the ELS staff elected Justin as the National Director commencing in January 2015.

In February 2015, Justin unexpectedly lost his wife due to a sudden illness. During that time of discouragement, the Lord spoke truth and encouragement into Justin's life.

Today, Justin has the privilege of leading the growing ELS India team with a staff of around 80. Justin would like to thank the earlier leaders of ELS, Mr. V.M. Abraham, Mrs. Selly Benjamin, Mr. Benjamin Gnanamanickam and Mr. Christopher Robert for their sacrificial and dedicated service.

We cannot wait to see what the Lord has in store for our team in ELS India. Please, keep Justin and the team in your prayers.

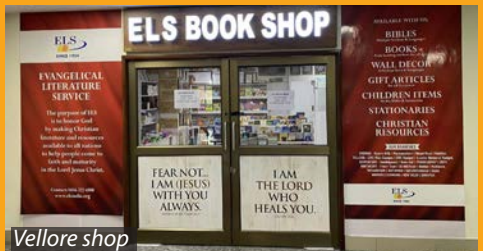

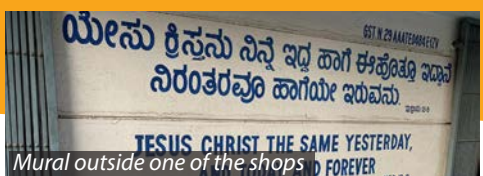

DONATION PROJECT: 25,000 Children's Bibles

Help us print 25,000 in multiple languages!

During a trip to our CLC ministry in Chiang Mai, Thailand last year, I was struck by how few Bibles were available for children in the Thai language. I knew that we had to do something about this lack of materials for different age groups for our precious children. As I spoke to some colleagues, we realised that this was a problem in many countries.



These are typically countries with relatively small evangelical populations and where the print runs are small. One of the problems is that the costs for a print run of only 700 or 1,000 copies is very expensive, thus making the Bibles unaffordable in some of our countries. Another difficulty, especially for Africa, is that the Bibles may already exist in French and in English, and even be very affordable in France, the UK and the USA, but in the African context they are simply unaffordable. The retail price is already too high and, in addition to that, international transport and importation costs need to be added. Yet, should that stop us from wanting to supply affordable Bibles for children?

We have pinpointed the following

countries where CLC ministers that have a need for children's Bibles for different ages and that have limited resources to print or to purchase them: Benin, Bulgaria, Burkina Faso, India, Ivory Coast, Mozambique, Myanmar, Pakistan, Portugal and Thailand. Costs include obtaining foreign language rights, translation fees, printing and shipping.

The project will undoubtedly take several years to complete. We are collaborating with publishers like Copenhagen and David C. Cook to obtain the rights for translation. Each Bible costs between \$2.50 and \$5.00 to print, depending on the size. Shipping costs are extra.

Please consider helping us put 25,000 age-appropriate Bibles into the hands of children in the countries listed above. Many parents and grandparents read the Bibles to their children, thus whole families can be impacted by the Bible stories. 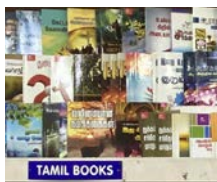

A Testimony from Charles at the ELS Bookshop in Secunderabad:

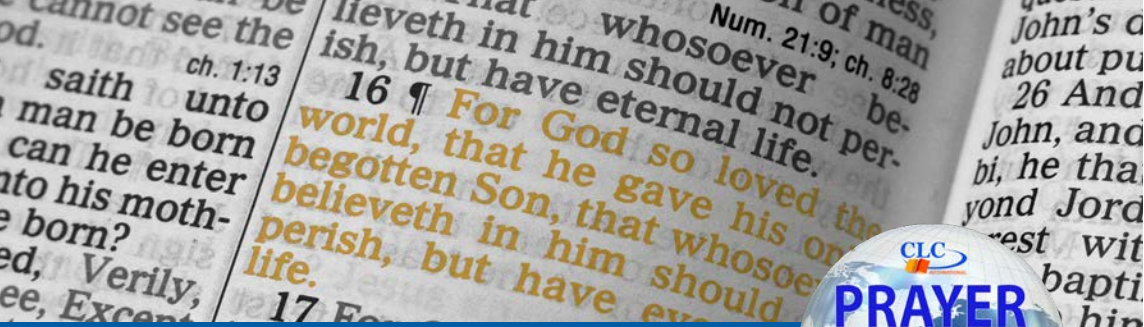
After reading the book *The Torn Veil*, the story of a Pakistani girl named Gulshan

Week 27 - Outreach

Monday (1st) - Cyprus

July and August are usually quiet due to the holiday season, so we are glad for a couple of opportunities to hold book tables, beginning this week at a children's camp which offers a unique possibility for these children to obtain Christian literature and gift items. The second one will take place around the middle of August at a Christian family camp. Please pray for strength for all the work involved and for good sales!

Tuesday (2nd) - Thailand

Later this month, CLC Thailand has the opportunity to hold a book table in a remote place. Please pray for provision of good transport facilities to take us and the books, protection along the way, and good conversations and encouraging sales when we arrive there. Thank you.

Wednesday (3rd) - Dominica

At the time of writing, our sales have been steady, but special occasions such as Mother's Day have not been as busy as we hoped. Nonetheless, we are grateful that new customers continue to come to the shop. In the months of July and August, we will be seeking to collaborate with ministries that may have summer events, so please pray that we will have opportunities to hold outdoor book tables during this time.

Thursday (4th) - United Kingdom

Due to the fact that a large proportion of our work is distributed through our warehouse in Chester, we have limited opportunities to connect with the public face-to-face. However, we are committed to growing our book tables at events, and August is a particularly busy time for this. Please pray for all the folk involved in planning and preparing and then serving the customers, when the time comes.

Friday (5th) - Mozambique

Please pray for CLC Maputo's involvement in an annual conference which is held each July. This is an initiative of a Christian publisher in Brazil, and our Maputo team usually handle some of the logistics as well as providing a book table with Bibles and other stock. The dates this year are 18th - 20th of this month.



The Weekend (6th - 7th) - Colombia

We thank God for the project, *Reading and Writing with Purpose*, whereby we are reaching a growing number of adults who neither read nor write. We believe this is a way to contribute to the people of our nation by helping them in their personal and spiritual growth.

July 8th - 14th

Week 28- Latin America

Monday (8th) - Ecuador

We are thankful for our partnership with CLC Colombia and with the R-Center in South Korea, enabling two teaching seminars this month (July 11th in Quito and 13th in Guayaquil) on the *Covenant of the Torch* (Book 5 in the *History of Redemption* series by Rev. Abraham Park). We are praying for a good level of participation and for lasting blessing in individual lives as a result of these events.

Tuesday (9th) - Colombia

We thank God for His care and support until today, and we ask for prayer for the remodelling of a bookstore in the city of Barranquilla and another in the city of Bogota. We also request prayer for resources for a new Bible project in addition to the reprinting of existing Bibles under the CLC publishing label.

Wednesday (10th) - Venezuela

We ask for prayer that we may maintain a good level of inventory so that our customers can always find something to bless their spiritual life and so that we may be able to cover all our expenses in the face of new government measures. Also, please pray for a blessing for our country following the general election which will be held on July 28th.

Please pray that there will be no delays in our shipments from the USA and that we may be able to clear our stock promptly through customs when it arrives, so as not to incur additional storage and other charges. Wednesday (17th) - South Korea

VBS (Vacation Bible School) for Kindergarten to Elementary School students will take place in the middle of July in Korea, and during this time of the year, many large churches in Korea place orders for children's books. Please pray for us that the books will have a tremendous impact in the lives of many young readers!

Please pray that she will have great joy in this work and that it will produce great results for the ministry of CLC Thailand. Monday (22nd) - France

As you will be aware, the Olympic Games are being held in France from 26th July - 11th August. To celebrate this event, CLC France has published a biography of Eric Liddell, the Christian Olympic medallist in Paris in 1924, made famous through the film "Chariots of Fire". Our bookshops in Paris will be open throughout the Games, despite the anticipated logistical challenges associated with the event.

Tuesday (23rd) - Italy

During our team conference, we conducted elections for the National Director and the leadership team. Ivano Cramerotti was reelected as the National Director. Three other staff, Roberta, Silvia and Luigi, were elected to be part of the leadership team. We ask you to pray for this group of people so that they may work in harmony and in submission to God's will for CLC in Italy.

Wednesday (24th) - Italy

Please pray for all our team members to have the opportunity to be recharged, both

Week 31 - Publishing



Monday (29th) - Global

Praise God with us for the growth of CLC global publishing over the past 10 years. By God's grace we now have almost 5,000 titles in print in 23 countries, including Bibles in various languages! CLC in South Korea is by far the largest publishing country for our global ministry, followed by France, USA, Colombia and the Philippines. Please pray for all our publishing teams, for wisdom in which manuscripts to choose.

Tuesday (30th) - Global

Our new global publishing project is to print 25,000 children's Bibles for countries where very few are available, or they are too expensive for people to afford. Our goal is to supply these Bibles for Benin, Burkina Faso, India, Indonesia, Ivory Coast, Mozambique, Myanmar, Pakistan, Poland, Portugal, Thailand and the Philippines. Please pray with us for financial provision for this project. See page 27.

Wednesday (31st) - Philippines

There are two reference books that we would like to publish this year, notably Wiersbe's expository teachings on the Old and New Testaments. At the time of writing we do not have sufficient funds. The project is urgent for us as the contracts for the right to publish will otherwise expire. Please pray with us for the LORD's provision for these projects.

Thursday (August 1st) - Philippines

In addition to the reference books mentioned yesterday, we would also like to publish the *KJV Kids' Devotional Bible*, which is a beautiful book with full colour illustrations. Again, we need funds for this before the contract lapses. Thank you for praying with us for this and for other titles that need to be printed before the end of the year.

Friday (2nd) - Romania

We thank God for His help concerning the advancement of our much delayed publishing

projects, the completion of which will allow us to start new projects. Please pray for wisdom to choose the best titles in order to bring valuable resources to our Publishing House, and for a good planning and coordination in order to have a better-controlled process in our publishing activities.

The Weekend (3rd - 4th) - Around the World

Please pray as our publishing activities continue to grow around the world and as lives are being challenged and encouraged by these excellent books. Our goal is to see people of all nations come to put their trust in Jesus Christ and then mature in their faith in Him.

August 5th - 11th

Week 32 - Worldwide

Monday (5th) - Portugal

For a long time, we were paying for an additional member to join our small team of one full-time and one half-time worker. We are thankful that Patricia, who sometimes helped us voluntarily, has joined us full-time, and so we can now say that we are two and a half! As the work is growing, we needed this reinforcement to handle the increased work load in the bookshop and outside, with opportunities to serve at events.

Tuesday (6th) - Portugal

We praise God for the successful launch and sales of our newest publication, *Homens sem Nome no Velho Testamento* (Men without a Name in the Old Testament) by Portuguese author Clarisse Barros. The book invites us to take a look at a number of men who were used by God but whose names are not revealed to us in the Bible. The book encourages us by showing us that in all that we do, we are seen and known by God.

Wednesday (7th) - Japan



Please pray for the “Mustard Seed” in Japan, a Centre which focuses on helping people with special needs. The bookshop is a part of this, encouraging reading in a culture where, overall, people seem to be reading less. Pray for Gaika, who manages the bookshop. Pray for ways to stimulate especially the Christian believers to develop and maintain good reading habits, particularly the Bible.

Thursday (8th) - South Korea

This month, we are in the final stages of printing theological textbooks for the autumn semesters, so please pray for us that we will be able to keep to deadlines so that we can provide the books to the theological seminaries on time. Thank you.

Friday (9th) - South Korea

At the end of this month, representatives from CLC Korea will be attending the Korea Christian Rights Fair for two days. Please pray for Sung and Sohee Park, as they meet many publishers coming from Europe and the USA. Pray that they will be able to choose the most appropriate titles for publishing in South Korea and that they will have good fellowship with the rights managers.

The Weekend (10th - 11th) - Worldwide

Please pray for CLC in the countries where the economic and political situations are unfavourable and even the religious environment can be hostile at times. Pray for our staff and their families in these countries and pray that our ministry may be able to continue in these places as a “light to the nations” for many more years.

So we are grateful for our intern student from Germany, Conni Haidinger, who has been serving in our bookshop this summer. Please pray for the CLC USA Multi-language Media department, that we may be a blessing to various ministries who are looking for Bibles and Gospel-centred resources in different languages. Please pray especially for our Publications department, that we will have manuscripts that are in line with our mission statement and which, consequently, will serve as valuable resources for our customers.

Monday (19th) - Ivory Coast

Thursday (19th) - Kenya

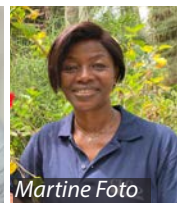
